I am writing to confirm that the South Eastern Health & Social Care Trust (the Trust) has now completed its search for the information relating to the above which you requested on 28 September 2017.

A response to your Question has been provided below by the Children's Services & Social Work Directorate.

Q1. *I would like to know how many Looked After Vietnamese Children (if possible, specifically Unaccompanied Asylum Seeking Children) went missing a) permanently, b) temporarily, each month from 2016 and 2017 to date?*

A1. There are no Vietnamese children within the Trust, therefore the response to the above question is nil.
