I am writing to confirm that the South Eastern Health & Social Care Trust (the Trust) has now completed its search for the information relating to the above which you requested on 14 November 2017.

The Children's Services and Social Work Directorate has reviewed your request and can advise that the Trust does not employ Detached Youth Workers therefore the answer to all of the questions is not applicable. The Detached Youth Workers in Northern Ireland are employed by the local Education Authority, not Health and Social Care.
