1.0 Introduction

This publication gives an overview of the work of the Infection Prevention & Control Committee during 2018-2019.

2.0 Background information

The Infection Prevention and Control Committee (IPCC) support the Lead Director for Infection Prevention & Control (Director of Nursing Primary Care & Older People) and the Medical Director in the implementation of an annual work plan aimed at preventing and reducing infection. The work strands encompass the themes taken from the Trust Infection Prevention & Control Strategy 2015-2018. A new Strategy for the next three years has been published and will be used to structure the work of the IPCC's Annual Action Plans.

The IPCC reports to the Safety Quality Improvement & Innovation Committee and supports the Healthcare-associated Infection (HCAI), Steering Group in initiatives aimed at the reduction of avoidable infection and improving the quality of patient care.

Trust Board members receive updates on HCAI, environmental cleanliness and other infection prevention & control issues throughout the year.

This report gives an overview of the activities of the Infection Prevention & Control Committee in 2018 -2019 and the plans for 2019-2020 which are already being implemented.
