

**Discharges from the South Eastern Trust for patients with a primary or secondary diagnosis (Sec Diag 1 - Sec Diag 15) of sepsis ICD10 codes - A40.0 - A41.9**

*In April 2017 the coding staff were advised to code **some** localised infections as sepsis. These included urosepsis, chest sepsis and biliary sepsis. This significantly increased the number of cases coded and was queried in 2018. As a result of this it was agreed regionally in 2019 to query with consultants if these localised infections resulted in sepsis'*

*It should be noted that our coding teams code morbidity and not mortality*

*The 'Deaths and Discharges' column includes both - deaths have not been identified as we cannot tell from coding if they died as a result of sepsis*
