Agenda item: Rural Needs Act 2016 – Annual Monitoring Report

1.0 Introduction

The Trust is required to produce an annual monitoring return to ensure compliance with Rural Needs Act 2016.

2.0 Background information

The Rural Needs Act 2016 means that from 1 June 2018, the Trust has a legal duty to ensure due regard is paid to the consideration of the social and economic needs of service users in rural areas when developing, adopting, implementing and revising policies, strategies and plans and when designing and implementing public services.

The information for 2019/20 has been requested for return to DEARA by 11 September 2020.
