

Bed occupancy modelling (SET vs regional data)


As of 25/01/22 there were 46 COVID patients in SET (Lab Positive) compared to the predicted SET model high of 88 at this time.









Daily ED attendances



Average daily wait from ambulance arrival to Triage


January data shows average daily waits ranging from between 25-195 minutes.






Weekly Acute Patient Discharges

The total discharged during the week of 09/01/22 was 430 compared to 384 on the week of 02/01/22






Bed days lost: complex delay>48 hours






Patients waiting for a bed at 9am.






Pressure ulcers

1347 new outpatients were seen in the week ending 8/1/22: 258 virtual and 1089 face to face






COVID outbreaks in care homes






Unallocated cases SET


