**Freedom of Information Act 2000
Information Relating to Persons who have died with No Known Next of Kin**

I am writing to advise you that the Trust has decided not to release the information which you requested on 13 July 2023 for the following reasons:

The Trust believes this information to be exempt under Section 41(1) of the Freedom of Information Act, which states:

41.—(1) Information is exempt information if —
(a) it was obtained by the public authority from any other person (including another public authority), and,
(b) the disclosure of the information to the public (otherwise than under this Act) by the public authority holding it would constitute a breach of confidence actionable by that or any other person.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 this letter acts as a Refusal Notice.

Under the terms of the legislation, you have the right to seek a review of this decision within the Trust in the first instance. If you wish to do so, please write to me at the address below.
