I am writing to confirm that the South Eastern Health & Social Care Trust (the Trust) has now completed its search for information relating to the above, which you requested on 3 January 2023.

I have established that the Trust do not provide any intensive day/community treatment programmes for eating disorders. All Specialised Eating Disorder Services are commissioned through, and provided by the Belfast Health & Social Care Trust (Belfast Trust) therefore, the information you requested is not held. If, after receiving a response, you remain unhappy, you can refer your complaint to the Information Commissioner at The Information Commissioner's Office –Northern Ireland, 3rd Floor, 14 Cromac Place, Belfast, BT7 2JB. It is important to note that if you refer any matter to the Information Commissioner, you will need to show evidence of having gone through the Trust's internal review procedure to try to resolve the matter with the Trust in the first instance.
