GP OUT OF HOURS

The GP Out of Hours (Downedoc) service operates overnight from 6.00pm to 8.00am weekdays, and 24 hours on week-ends and public holidays. The service is accessed by telephone: **028 9260 2204**

Urgent Care Centre / Minor Injury Unit at Downe Hospital 028 4483 8091

PHONE FIRST. The Urgent Care Centre is Consultant led and currently operates 8am-6pm, Monday-Friday. This centre is NOT equipped to treat cardiac pain, strokes or major accidents. The Minor Injury Unit is Nurse led and currently operates 9am-5pm, Saturday-Sunday.

New 24/7 Emergency Department at Ulster Hospital

Minor Injury Unit (Consultant Led) also at the Ulster Hospital runs 7 days a week 8am to 6pm. This is a WALK IN SERVICE.
